## “CNOMO” INTERFACE EXTENSION

### Wide Choice of Solenoids

EEExia, EEExd, EEExm, ExN and IP65 Safe Area

Many more RGS solenoid valves are now available with the option of the CNOMO interface. This feature is now included on all standard 1/8”, 1/4” and 1/2”; remote, manifold and sub-base mounted valves, including all 3/2, 5/2 and 5/3 functions.

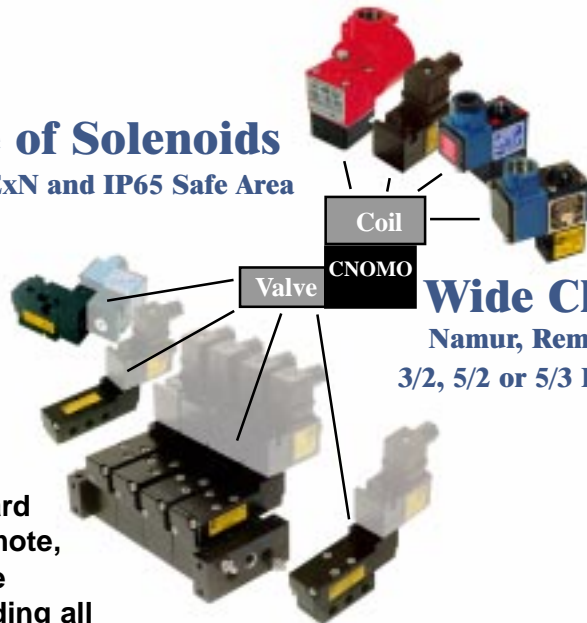
Full details of the extension to the range of CNOMO interface valves can be found in the latest release of the RGS catalogue which is available from the Sales Office on request.

reduced stock value of CNOMO compatible solenoid and spool valve subassemblies, rather than carrying complete assemblies of all the variations.

The interchangeability of the solenoid and spool valve also means that less common permutations can be supported from stock without carrying these units as complete units.

Please note that whilst the CNOMO units will be provided as standard, RGS will continue to support the previous style of solenoid valve. These are available on request without a price premium.

### -- Stop Press -- Stop Press -- All RGS Namur Mount Valves

After 20th September 2000 the rotatable changeover plate that is currently supplied with most RGS Namur mount valves will be replaced by two separate 3/2 and 5/2 interface plates. These two plates are clearly marked as “3/2” and “5/2” respectively; can be fitted without using any tools and are of the same physical size as the existing plate. Note that the function and performance of the installed valve is unaltered, so the part numbers will remain unchanged. Please contact the RGS Sales Office for further information.
